Sheva Brachot

During the week following a wedding, a series of seven blessings (Sheva Brachot) is recited at any festive meal for the bride and groom that is attended by a minyan.

Following the completion of the meal, a cup of wine is used to lead the Grace After Meals. After the Grace After Meals, a second cup of wine is filled and people are honored with reciting each of the first six blessings. Then, the person who led Grace After Meals recites the seventh blessing over the first cup of wine, and drinks some.

Finally, the wine from the two cups is mixed together, and given to both the bride and groom – and anyone else wishing to partake of this "cup of blessing."
