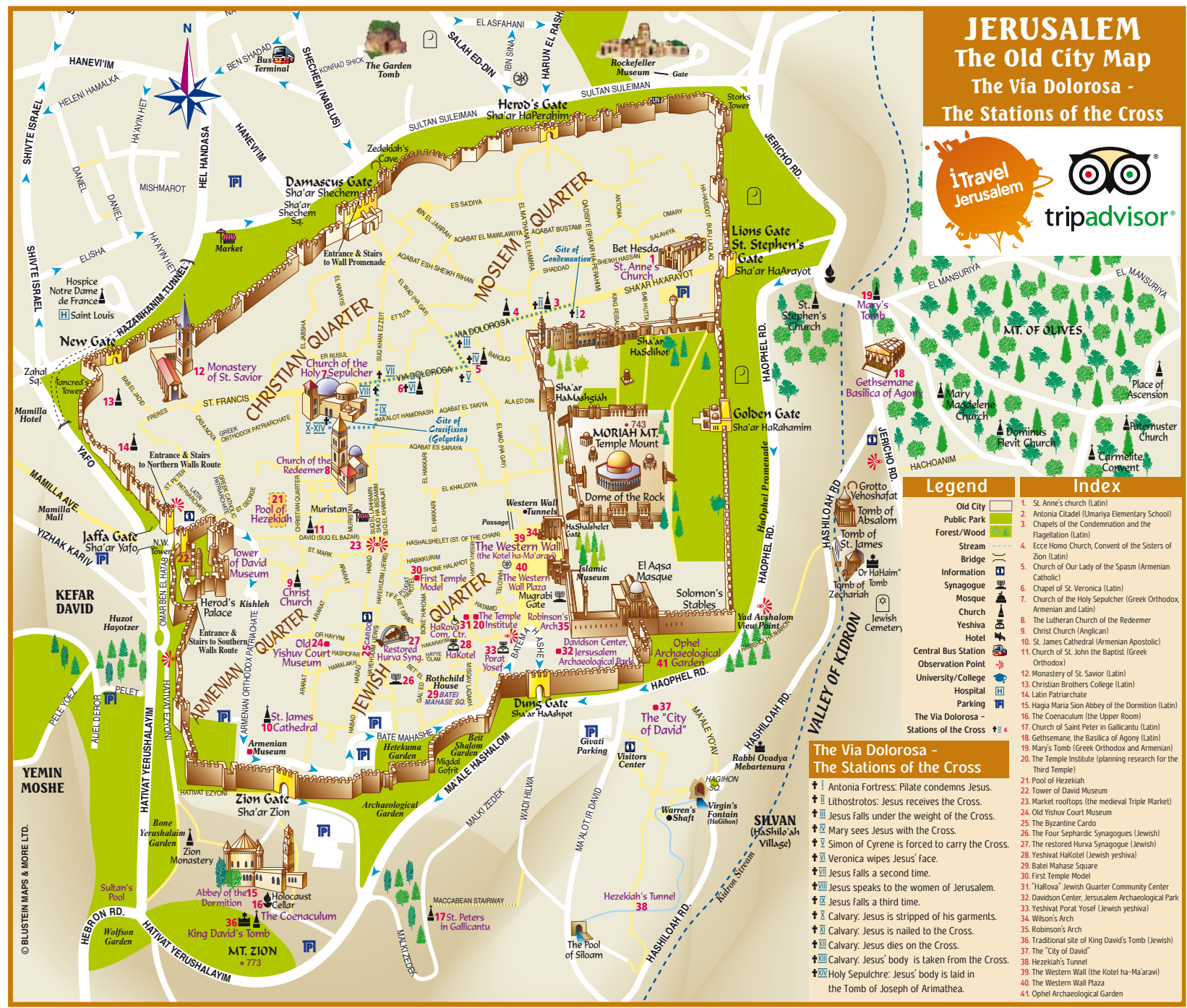
The Old City Map

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2. Antonia Citadel (Umayyad Elementary School)
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The Via Dolorosa - The Stations of the Cross

- I Antonia Fortress: Pilate condemns Jesus.
- II Lithotrosts: Jesus receives the Cross.
- III Jesus falls under the weight of the Cross.
- IV Mary sees Jesus with the Cross.
- V Simon of Cyrene is forced to carry the Cross.
- VI Veronica wipes Jesus' face.
- VII Jesus falls a second time.
- VIII Jesus speaks to the women of Jerusalem.
- IX Jesus falls a third time.
- X Calvary: Jesus is stripped of his garments.
- XI Calvary: Jesus is nailed to the Cross.
- XII Calvary: Jesus' body is taken from the Cross.
- XIII Holy Sepulchre: Jesus' body is laid in the Tomb of Joseph of Arimathea.
